A FEW WORDS FROM JEANNE

It is a wonderful thing when you can honestly testify that you know God has forgiven your sins and if He has redeemed you should say so publicly and as scripture says...*we overcome our enemy by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of our testimony* – so here goes!

From a very early age , my Grandma would always sing to me about being a ‘Sunbeam for Jesus’ and as I grew a little older then I recall hearing her quote scriptures, like ‘the Lord will provide’ and ‘the Lord’s my shepherd, I shall not want’. I didn’t quite understand what Grandma meant at the time but if this Jesus was important to her then He must be someone special.

Mum and Dad always made sure that we children(my older brother, sister and myself)attended Sunday School and so my younger days were given over to a child’s knowledge of Jesus and His love. At the age of twelve I had the opportunity, at church event, of ‘accepting Jesus into my heart’ and so remembering all the wonderful things Grandma had told me about her Jesus, I surrendered my heart to Him.

Unfortunately, as my teenage years loomed, Grandma died, and I became more in love with the world and worldly pleasures than I was with Jesus and His Kingdom.
